

HEALTH AND SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

AAPPR's top priority is the health and safety of our conference participants. In the interest of public and attendee safety and comfort and to comply with the City of Chicago's mitigation requirements, AAPPR will require all conference participants to be fully vaccinated. Proof of vaccination will need to be provided to attend the conference. Details on how to submit proof will be shared following registration.

Individuals who have previously received a medical or religious exemption are exempt, provided these patrons show proof of the medical or religious exemption along with a negative COVID-19 test, administered by a medical professional, within 72 hours of the start of the conference.

AAPPR will enforce any federal, state, or local mandates as they exist at the time of the event. Those who don't comply will be asked to leave the event. Currently, Chicago requires mask use indoors. All residents and visitors to Chicago are strongly encouraged to follow public health safety measures. AAPPR asks that all attendees acknowledge the event waiver and liability release in their event registration.

To ensure that all feel comfortable and safe at our event, some extra distance may be implemented in gatherings, dining areas, and seating situations. Expect that dining events including breaks, meals, and receptions may be modified from our usual format to accommodate masking/distancing requirements.

For everyone's safety, please do not arrive to the meeting ill or with any symptoms of COVID-19 or other similar flu viruses. AAPPR is not responsible for losses in airfare/hotel due to non-attendance for any reason. Please plan accordingly when making reservations. If you develop symptoms while at the meeting, please quarantine yourself and notify a member of the AAPPR staff.
